Year 3/4 Visit Ripon Cathedral

Year 3/4 recently enjoyed a special trip to Ripon Cathedral for a Sacred Art Day based on the theme “*Roots of Love.*”

During the day, the children explored ideas about who we are, how we grow and develop, and the importance of religion, faith, and family in shaping our lives. Through creative activities and reflection, pupils produced thoughtful work expressing their own “roots” and what matters most to them.

Learning Together: “Fix It, Not Fight It”

Thank you to all the parents and carers who joined us for our recent Learning Together sessions. It was fantastic to see children and families working together, with lots of great discussion—and some brilliant acting too!

We focused on a simple approach we use in school to help children manage disagreements:

☀️ **STOP – THINK – FIX**

- STOP – pause and calm down
- THINK – what happened and how others feel
- FIX – put things right and move forward

A key message we shared was:

We don't focus on who is right—we focus on putting things right.

This helps children take responsibility, repair friendships and move on positively.

Using the same language and approach at school and at home means that children are far more confident in applying it. Why not try it for yourself?

Thank you again for your support—working together makes a real difference in helping children develop these important life skills.
