Breakfast Club & Afterschool Club Booking Reminder

We have noticed that a small number of children have been attending Breakfast Club or Afterschool Club without being booked in advance.

For safeguarding reasons, it is essential that all children are booked into these clubs beforehand. This ensures we know which pupils are expected to be on site and allows us to staff the clubs safely and appropriately.

Please make sure you book your child into Breakfast Club or Afterschool Club in advance and do not send them in unless a booking has been confirmed.

Reminder: Snacks for Afterschool Club

Children are welcome to bring a snack with them to afterschool club, and they will be given plenty of time at the start of the session to eat it. Please ensure that any snacks follow our school food policy. Snacks should not include crisps, sweets, cakes, or chocolate.

We would also like to remind families that we are a nut-free site due to serious allergies within our school community. Please check snacks carefully before sending them into afterschool club.

Lip Balm in School

We have noticed an increasing number of pupils bringing lip balms into school. While we understand they can be helpful, lip balms can easily be lost, shared, or become a distraction during the school day.

If your child needs to bring lip balm into school, please ensure it is either handed in to the school office for safekeeping or kept at home. Pupils should not keep lip balm in their bags, or pockets during the school day.

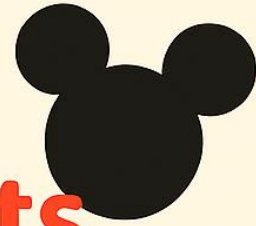

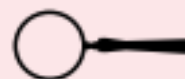
