Armed Forces Day for Children – Event Cancellation

It is with great regret that we must inform you that this year's Armed Forces Day for Children will no longer be taking place.

Catterick Garrison Headquarters have advised that, due to the current operational tempo, there are insufficient units available to support the event. This has led to a lack of capacity to provide both the activities and catering that are central to making the day such a special and memorable experience for children and families.

We know how much this event is valued by our community, and we share in the disappointment that it cannot go ahead this year. Armed Forces Day has always been a

highlight of the calendar, offering a unique opportunity for children to engage with and celebrate the work of our Armed Forces in a fun and meaningful way.

We appreciate your understanding and we very much hope to see the return of this much-loved event in the future.

Communicating with Parents During a Site Lockdown

The safety and wellbeing of our pupils is always our highest priority. To help families stay informed, we regularly share our lockdown procedures with parents and carers through newsletters and the school website.

In the unlikely event of a lockdown, we will communicate updates to parents and carers as soon as it is practical to do so. In some situations, this communication may be coordinated with emergency services and the senior staff member leading the response.

How you can help during a lockdown:

- **Please do not call the school office.** Phone lines need to remain free for communication between the school and emergency services.
- **Please do not come to the school site.** This could hinder emergency access and may put you or others at risk.
- **Please wait for further instructions.** Once it is safe to do so, we will provide clear guidance on when and where children can be collected. A designated safe collection point will be arranged if needed.

During a lockdown, the school site will be fully secured. Entrances may be closed and the office may not be staffed, as all attention will be focused on keeping everyone safe.

We appreciate your understanding and cooperation. By working together, we can ensure the best possible outcome for all.

Sun Safety and Sunscreen in School

As the weather becomes warmer, we would like to remind families about our approach to sun safety and the use of sunscreen in school.

We are committed to helping children stay safe in the sun and reducing the risk of skin damage caused by harmful UV rays. Throughout the school day, children are encouraged to take simple precautions such as seeking shade, drinking plenty of water, and wearing suitable clothing and hats when outdoors.

Sunscreen can provide additional protection, particularly during sunny weather or for outdoor activities. If your child needs to use sunscreen in school, we ask parents and carers to support us in the following ways:


- Please provide a suitable sunscreen (SPF 30+ or higher is recommended).
- Ensure the bottle is clearly labelled with your child's name.
- Check and replenish supplies regularly.
- Provide non-aerosol products only.

Children in most year groups are expected to apply their own sunscreen. For our youngest pupils in Nursery and Reception, we ask that sunscreen is applied at home before school, and staff will help to reapply it when needed.

If a child requires support from staff with applying sunscreen, it will only be applied to exposed areas such as the face, neck, arms, hands and lower legs. Parents should provide clear written instructions if this support is needed.

You can also help by encouraging your child to bring and wear a sun hat and, where possible, clothing that helps protect their skin during outdoor learning, playtimes and school trips.
