#### **Emotion Coaching**

Emotion Coaching is a way of helping children understand and manage their feelings. When a child is upset or struggling, adults use empathy to connect with them and help them calm down. Once the child is feeling more settled, they can talk through what happened and learn better ways to respond next time.

It's not about excusing poor behaviour but about using emotional moments as opportunities to teach and support children in a positive, respectful way.


