Thank you for your interest in joining our Sharow CE Nursery family. We're delighted that you're considering us for the beginning of your child's learning journey.

At Sharow CE School, our Early Years setting brings together Nursery and Reception children (ages 3–5) in a warm, caring and inspiring environment. We believe that children learn best through play, exploration, and following their own curiosity. Every day is filled with opportunities to imagine, discover and grow — whether that's building, painting, storytelling, investigating the outdoors, or making new friends.

Our experienced team carefully plans a balance of child-initiated and adult-guided experiences, designed to support independence and nurture a lifelong love of learning. We value each child as an individual and celebrate their unique interests and abilities. We also place great importance on building strong, trusting relationships with our families, working together to ensure every child feels safe, valued and ready to flourish.

All children are entitled to 15 hours of government-funded nursery provision from the term after their third birthday. Families who meet certain criteria may be eligible for up to 30 hours of funded provision. If you would like to purchase additional hours, these are available at £5.75 per hour (in 3-hour blocks). - Income-based Jobseekers Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guaranteed element of State Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
