### School Information

#### **Lunchtime Reminder: Safe Food Preparation**

We kindly ask parents and carers to ensure that all food sent into school is prepared safely for children to eat independently.

Please make sure that foods which could pose a choking risk are cut into small, manageable pieces, for example:

- Grapes and cherry tomatoes should be cut lengthways
- Sausages should be sliced lengthways and then into smaller pieces
- Cheese strings should be pulled apart or cut into smaller pieces
- Pepperami sticks and similar items should be cut into small pieces
- Larger fruits or vegetables should be chopped appropriately

Taking these simple steps helps reduce the risk of choking and keeps all children safe during snack and lunchtimes.
