



Fairytales: Goldilocks and the Three Bears – Week One & Two

The theme for our learning for this new half term will be 'Fairy tales, Legends and Myths' with a focus on the classic story Goldilocks and the Three Bears for the first two weeks.

<p><u>Communication and Language</u></p> <p>Making and tasting porridge- which one will be the favourite?</p> <p>Small world- Bear's house in the woods</p> <p>Making character puppets. Talk about what the characters looked like? What size are they? How do bears feel?</p>	<p><u>Personal, Social and Emotional Development</u></p> <p>Why do you think Goldilocks let herself into the Bear's house?</p> <p>What would you do if you were Goldilocks?</p> <p>Explore how Baby Bear felt when he found his chair broken and porridge eaten.</p>	<p><u>Physical Development</u></p> <p>Discuss healthy eating- healthy breakfasts. Sort breakfasts into healthy and unhealthy. Read- 'Eat your veggies Goldilocks'</p> <p>Oats and tweezers to practice fine motor skills. Fill the Bear's bowls.</p> <p>Go on a bear hunt! Play 'Here comes the bears.' Tag with bears.</p>
<p><u>Expressive Arts and Design</u></p> <p>Make new and improved chairs for the three Bears- How can you make them strong enough? Test them using teddy bears.</p> <p>Explore texture- painting bears using forks</p>	<p><u>Literacy</u></p> <p>Set up a crime scene where a chair is broken, a bed is broken and porridge eaten. Children take on the role of the police and ask questions to find out clues- who was the culprit?</p> <p>Catching Goldilocks- create wanted posters. Description writing.</p>	<p><u>Understanding the World</u></p> <p>Sensory tray with oats. Children will also explore adding water to see what happens.</p> <p>Look at different types of bears- find out some facts.</p> <p>Gummy Bear experiment!</p>
<p><u>Mathematics</u></p> <p>Order items by size subitising 3 weighing and measuring porridge</p>	<p><u>Ideas to Explore at Home</u></p> <p>Go on your own bear hunt- take a walk in your local woods. I wonder what you'll find?</p> <p>Learn the Goldilocks song! When Goldilocks went to the house of the bears - BBC Teach</p>
