#### **1. Engaging with Parents**

Parents found it easier to access being online, rather than face to face.

Jacqui shared they have had a reading evening in school and a SATs evening which no-one attended. It was information meetings would be helpful if they moved to online, to support parents being able to attend.

Parents suggested that a column is added to the diary dates on the newsletter to identify which children it related to.

Jacqui shared information on Positive Regard in school and asked the best way forward for parents to be able to attend.

Parents shared regarding Positive Regard, could we have a meeting and also send information home

Parents suggested that school gain an idea of how many parents will be attending prior to the meeting (send out meeting invites).

## **2. Positive Regard**

Information was discussed and explained what this is:

Wellspring Academy Trust is the supplier and Mrs Palmer and MRs Curzon has both received 5 full days of training. Having a positive regard for each other (focus on relationships) and how better to support children in school. Shared how staff can have support to develop themselves.

## **3. Learning together mornings**

Mornings are better attended than afternoon. Parents who do attend support other children. Children are used to having other adults in school and sharing their work with them.

## **4. Staffing for next year**
